Historic Preservation

- The Cedars, built around 1840 and celebrating 175 years in 2016, is Jackson's oldest surviving residential structure, now managed by FRF and used for art shows and special events.
- The Phoenix Initiative, a facade grant program benefitting homeowners, is a program funded through St. Dominic's and neighborhood churches.
- To date, over 70 homes have been completed.
- Fondren Park, constructed by FRF and the City of Jackson, was funded with a nearly \$600,000 HUD grant and includes amenities and green space used by area organizations, churches and neighborhood residents.
