

# PROJECT: FONDREN STREETScape PROJECT

The project will reconstruct the sidewalks throughout the Fondren Business District. This area includes sections of Old Canton Road, North State Street, Fondren Place and Duling Avenue. Landscaping, using plant species appropriate for the urban environment, will be installed. New sidewalks will meet current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) accessibility requirements and will include curb ramps that also meet ADA requirements. Modifications will be made to the traffic signals at the intersections within the project area to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility. Special features, including: distinctive signage, bicycle racks, way finding signs, removable bollards, sidewalk accents, distinctive street name signs, street furnishings, and a new transit shelter, will help create a unique theme to brand the Fondren Business District. Minor drainage improvements will also be included in the project.
